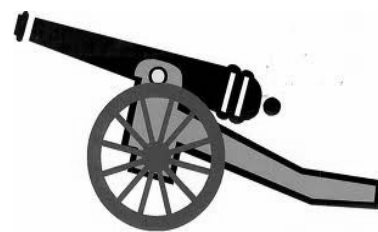

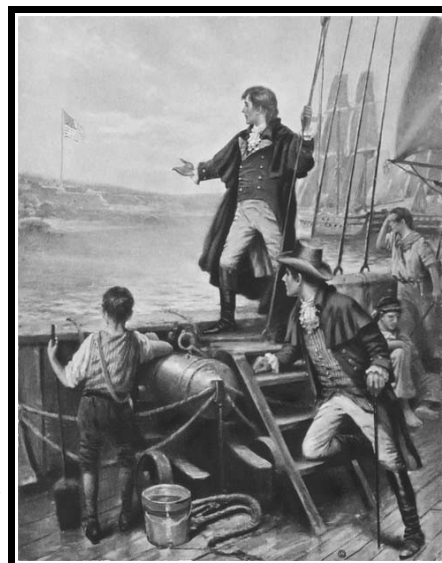
Star Spangled City

TOUR INCLUDES:

- ✓ **Ft. McHenry** This National Monument and Historic Shrine is where the people of Baltimore bravely defended the city from British attack in 1814. Francis Scott Key wrote the words to "The Star Spangled Banner" after witnessing the battle from the Patapsco River.
- ✓ **Mary Pickersgill Flag House.** This tiny house once belonged to Mary Young-Pickersgill, the Baltimore flag maker who crafted the 30'x42' banner that flew over Ft. McHenry and inspired Key's famous poem.
- ✓ **Federal Hill.** From high atop Federal Hill visitors will enjoy a panoramic view of Baltimore's ever-changing skyline and see monuments dedicated to the city's chief defenders during the War of 1812



- ✓ **Fells Point.** Among the oldest in Baltimore, this colorful neighborhood was once a shipbuilding community. Clipper ships constructed here were used by American privateers to wreak havoc on the British Merchant Fleet, heavily influencing the outcome of the war.
- ✓ **Mt. Vernon.** The nation's first monument to George Washington is the centerpiece of this Baltimore neighborhood, surrounded by gardens, museums, and stately townhouses. This is also where Key passed away while visiting family.
